I read the article in the Daily Camera about the motion opposing drilling under Rocky Flats and have read the text of the motion contained inside the meeting packet at <u>http://www.rockyflatssc.org/RFSC\_agendas/RFSC\_Bd\_mtg\_packet\_4\_19.pdf</u>.

As a homeowner in Superior I'm concerned there has not been adequate study to understand the risks associated with hydraulic fracturing beneath Rocky Flats. Based on my own recent interaction with COGCC officials (see <a href="http://bit.ly/2Puedb8">http://bit.ly/2Puedb8</a>) it seems unlikely there is a regulatory environment in place in Colorado to ensure adequate study would be undertaken before a drilling permit could potentially be approved.

The motion proposed by Trustee Lacis represents what I believe to be a common sense approach to Oil and Gas drilling proposals at Rocky Flats. I sincerely hope it earns your full support.

I also appreciate the work you are doing to draft questions for DOE, CDPHE and others which should be answered in detail before any application could be considered.
